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Introduction

Are you looking for an extension which allows to translate your content into any regional language and make your store global? To expand your business in multiple countries you need to exhibit your products in multiple languages. This can be done now using Language Translator extension.

This extension is quite simple and easy to install and configure. Using this extension, you can automatically translate the product attributes and Meta details of a specific page from one language to another through CRON processes. It will help you to manage your multi-lingual stores more efficiently. It is powered by Google API Key, which makes is imperative to purchase API keys to use this extension. It is a must have extension for store owners who run multi-lingual stores.

Benefits of Language Translator

- Helps to manage multilingual stores.
- Helps customers to better understand your products.
- Convert CMS page details like Page Title, Content Heading, Content and Meta Details in any language.
- Translate reviews from one language to another.
- Search and translate any string of the store.
- Mass translation for multiple store fields will be carried through CRON.
- Set Daily Character Limit for the translation and Set Safe Limit to be kept during translation.
- Calculate number of characters for product based on the attributes selected.

Installation

Installation Steps

Step 1: Check Permissions

- Make sure the “app” directories of your Magento and all directories inside it, have full written permissions or set permissions on the each directory equal to 777 or 0777.

Important! Change all permissions back after installation.

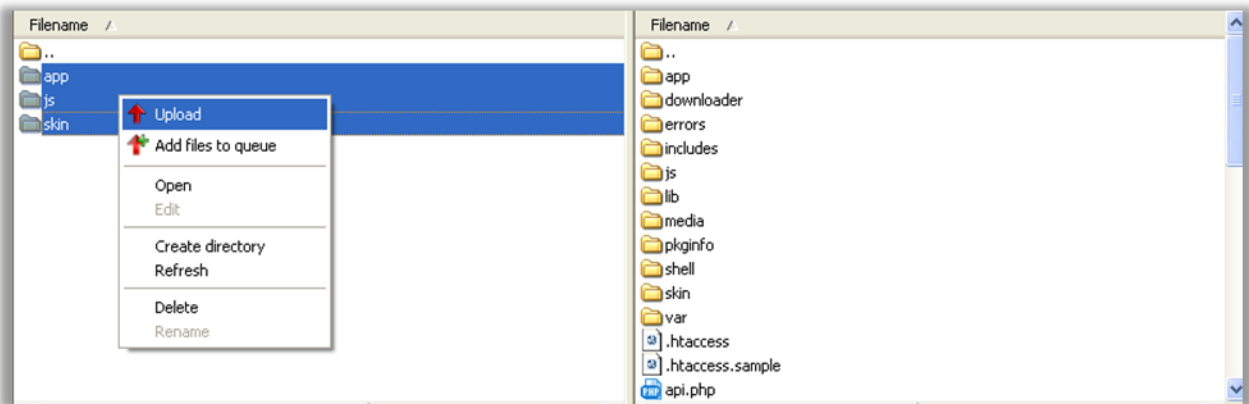

Step 2: Disable Compilation

- Log into Magento **Admin Panel** and go to **System** → **Tools** → **Compilation** and disable the compilation.
- After **step5** you can run the compilation process again.

Step 3: Upload Files

- Upload all folders from the extension package to the installation directory of your Magento software using an FTP client.



Step 4: Clear cache

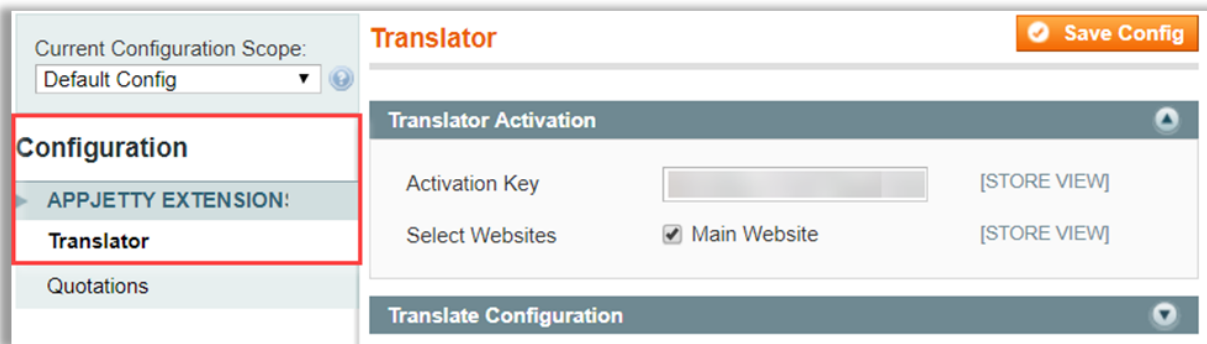
- Go to **System** → **Cache Management**.
- Clear the store cache.

Step 5: Re-login

- Logout and log back into **Magento Admin Panel**.

Step 6: Use Extension

- Go to **System → Configuration**.
- In the left column you will see the new tab **AppJetty Extensions**, now select **Translator**.



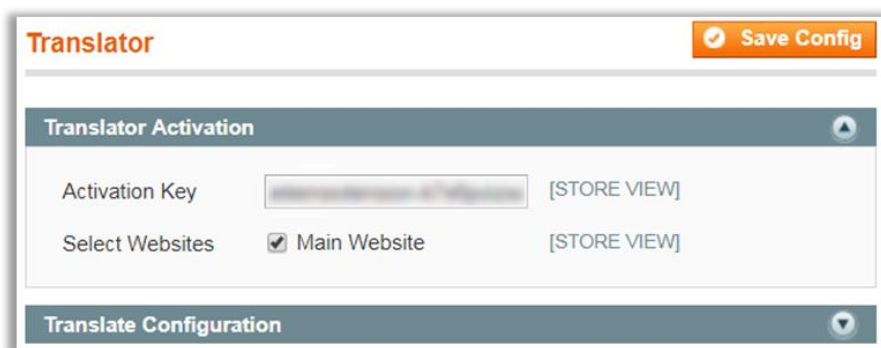
Extension Activation

Copy an activation key

- Copy the activation key from the Order Confirmation Mail. OR Login into your account at website using the e-mail and password that you provided at checkout process.
- Go to Downloadable Options and copy the activation key for the Language Translator extension.

Activate an extension

- Log into Magento **Admin Panel** and go to **System Configuration -> AppJetty Extensions/ Language Translator Extension** and enter the activation key in the '**Activation Key**' field for the **Language Translator** extension then click the '**Save Config**'.



Select Websites

- When you enter and save the key it will be verified on our server and you can select the websites where you need to use the **Language Translator** extension. Click the '**Save Config**' button after making your selections.
- You are now ready to use the **Language Translator** extension.
- Now, **Language Translator** got activated! You just have to set configurations.

Configuration

- Please follow the below steps to enable the functionality of Language Translator.
- Go to **System -> Configuration**. In the left column you will see the tab **AppJetty Extensions -> Translator**.
 - **Enabled:** Select '**Yes**' to enable the Language Translator extension. The extension is disabled by default.
 - **Enter Google API key:** It is used to translate the data(**Note:** Use this link to generate the Google API key (https://developers.google.com/translate/v2/getting_started))
 - **Enter Daily Quota:** Enter daily limit specified in your Google Billing Amount.
 - **Enter Safe Limit:** Enter a daily safe limit to avoid the errors while translating the content.

Note: It must be less than the value entered in '**Enter Daily Quota**' field

- **Language you want to translate your website to:** Translate the product data, category data, CMS page, CMS block, review fields and Meta data in defined language. If language has been not selected then it will be translates in current locale language.

Note: If you select '**Current locale**' then by default it will use current locale language.

- **Translate From:** Translate from specific language. If you select '**Auto Detect**' then it will automatically detect the language.
- **Translate Button Label:** Enter the text to be displayed on Translate button.

- Admin can manage the translations in various ways:

 - **Batch Size to translate:** Enter the number of products to be translated at a particular time.
 - **Calculate Characters:** To calculate and view the number of characters based on product configurations selected click on 'Calculate Characters' button.

- Go to **Catalog -> Manage Products** and click on any product to translate it to any other language.
- Go to **General** to translate general information. Go to **Meta Information** to change Meta Information of Product.
- You can translate all allowed data with global translate button besides save button.

Translate CMS Page Details & CMS Block Details from one language to another

- Go to **CMS -> Pages** and click on any page to translate it to any other language.
- Admin can translate **Page Information, Content** and **Meta Data** of the CMS Page.
- If we change the store view then the translate button will change to **translate to language** for that Store.

Translate Store Reviews to Any Language

- Go to **Catalog -> Reviews and Rating -> Customer Reviews -> All Reviews** and click on any review to translate it to any other language.
- If we change the store view then the translate button will change to **translate to language** for that store.

- Go to **AppJetty Translator -> Manage Translation -> Search String and Translate** and enter any string you want to translate in the search box.

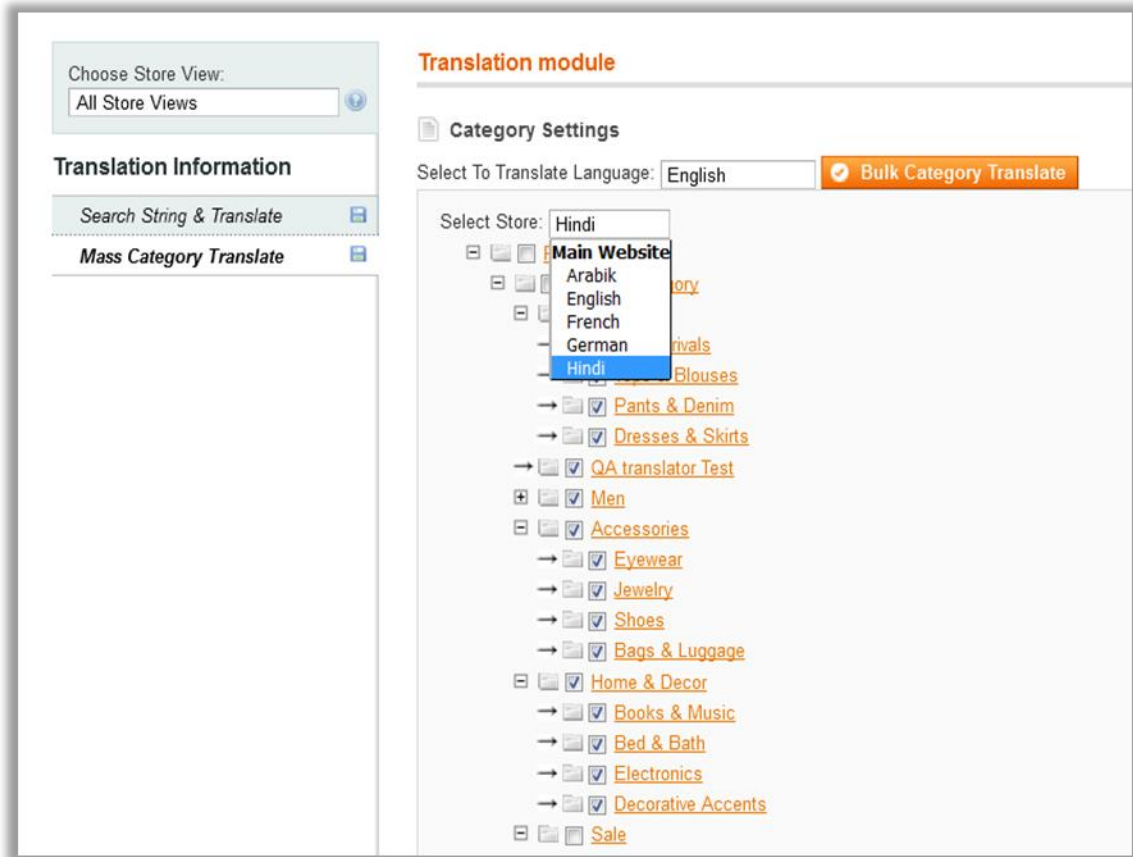

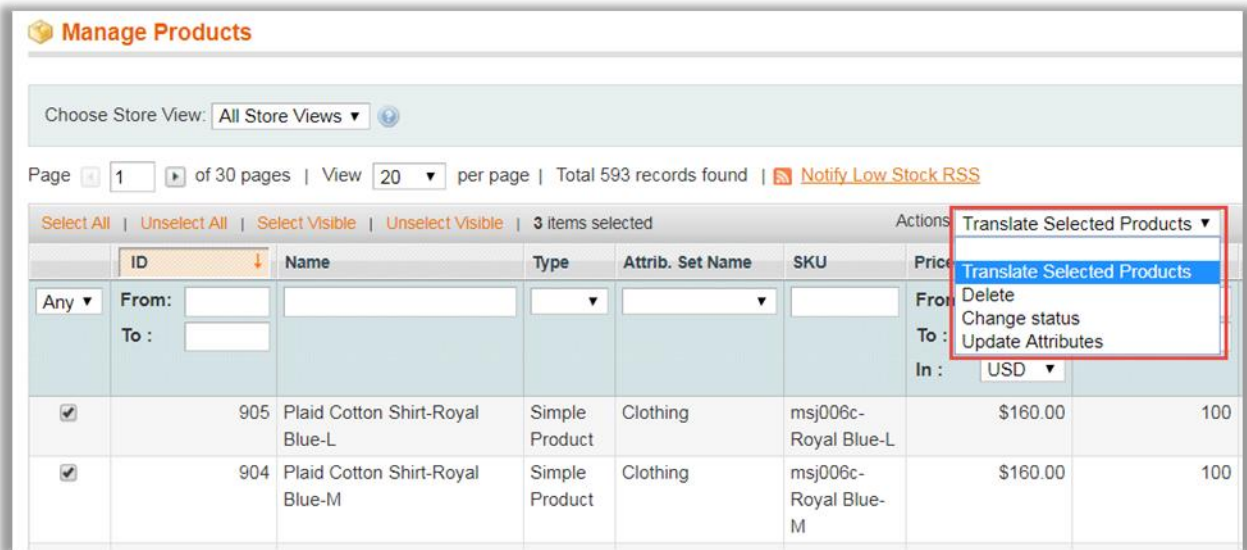
Translate Category in a Mass to any of the language

- Go to **AppJetty Translator -> Manage Translation -> Mass Category Translate** and select categories that you want to translate.
- Select the translate language and the store in which you want translated category.

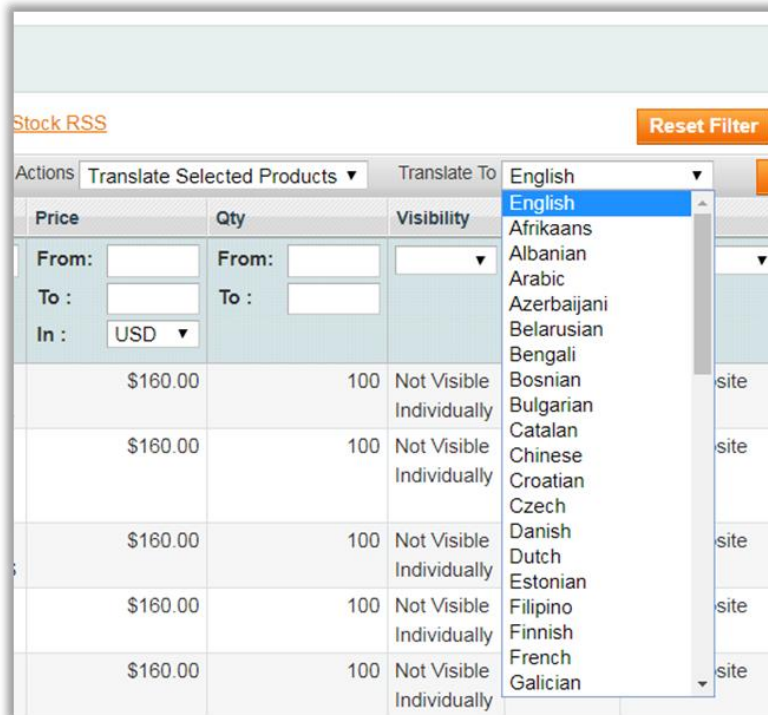


Mass Translation of Products, CMS Page Data, Static Blocks, Product Reviews and Tags


- Go to any of the category page that you want to translate and select multiple items by checking the checkbox.
- Click on ‘Actions’ dropdown list and select ‘Translate Selected CMS Pages’ (For Mass Translation).




- Select any language in which you want translation by clicking on the ‘Translate To’ button.



- Now click on 'Submit' button to translate all the selected attributes together. By clicking on 'Submit' button you will be notified with a message about the CRON Process by which the mass translation will be carried out.



Mass Translation Status

- To view the status of the mass translations carried out by CRONs go to **AppJetty Translator -> Manage CRON Translations**.
- Now you can view a list of CRONs in which the mass translation were carried out along with CRON statuses and other details.
